

Ask your cancer team about the **DETECT-2 study**

DETECT-2 is a study comparing cancer patients randomly assigned to either be offered genetic testing at home or in hospital

You may be eligible to take part if:

- You have been diagnosed with **bowel (colorectal), womb (endometrial),** or **ovarian** cancer
- You are being offered genetic testing as part of your cancer care

Participants will be randomly assigned to one of two groups. Participants will be unable to choose which group they are assigned to:

Standard hospital testing

Genetic testing information provided by a **member of your cancer team**




Genetic testing performed by a **blood test in hospital**

OR

Direct to patient testing

Genetic testing information provided on an **interactive web-app** that can be used anywhere

Genetic testing performed **at home** using a straightforward **saliva test**
